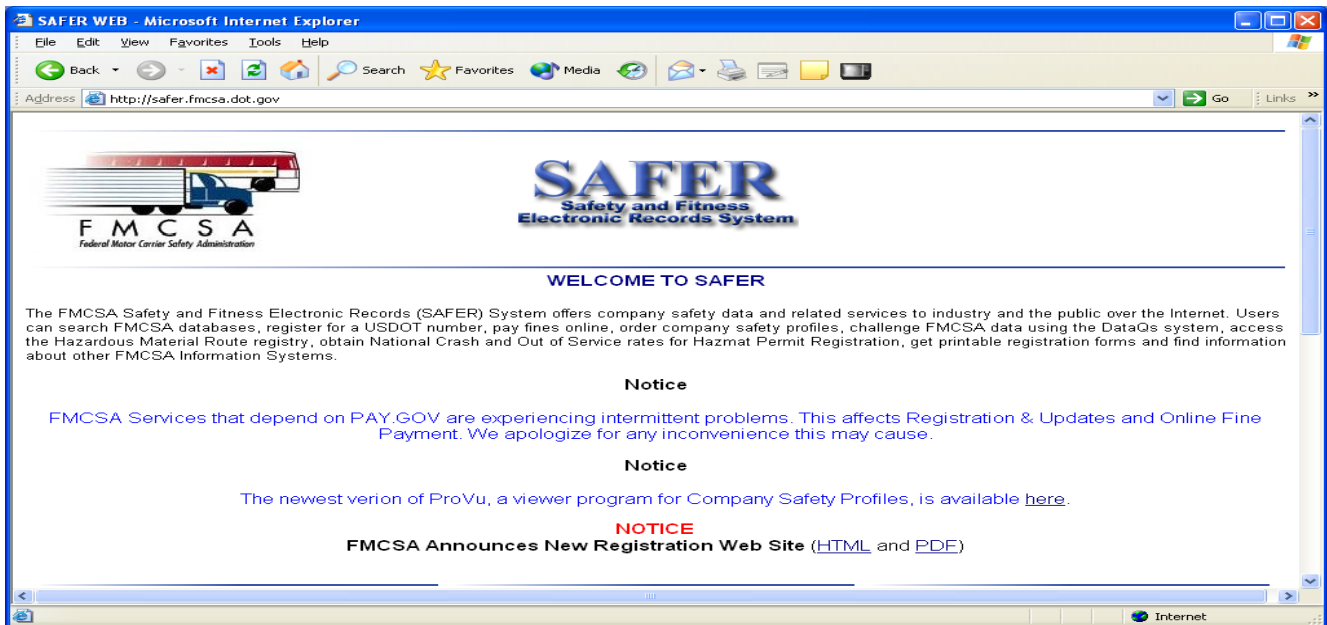


FMCSA Operating Authority

If you are a for-hire interstate carrier hauling regulated commodities, you must be granted operating authority (MC Number) from FMCSA. Operating Authority is **in addition** to your U.S. DOT Number.
